

Carbon Monoxide Alarms

Carbon Monoxide are silent, highly poisonous fumes that are produced by the incomplete burning of fossil fuels (ie coal, gas and wood).

Carbon Monoxide (CO) is difficult to detect because you cannot taste, see or smell it. This can happen when appliances such as boilers, cookers and fires are faulty, incorrectly fitted or not regularly serviced.



BCHG will regularly service your gas appliances and have fitted a CO detector in your home. It is extremely important that you allow us access to complete a gas service when we contact you.

If you experience an activation of the CO alarm please complete the following:



Open all doors and windows to ventilate your home.



Stop using all appliances, switch off boilers, fires and cookers.



Evacuate the property.
